

**Rockwell Collins Amateur Radio Club
Unescorted Facility Access**

It is the policy of Rockwell to preclude actions or relationships which could adversely affect the Corporation. As such, the following conditions apply to unescorted access for retired Rockwell personnel participating in RCARC activities:

- (1) Access is provided to the club stations and cafeteria for activities of the Radio Club only.
- (2) Access is at the sole discretion of Rockwell and may only be provided if the member is in good standing with Club bylaws.
- (3) All employment must be reported in writing to the Club President.
- (4) Any circumstance in which the interest, duties, obligations or activities of a retiree or any immediate family member may be in conflict or incompatible with the interests of the Corporation in general or with respect to any transaction must be reported in writing to the club President.

The following are examples of actual or potential conflicts in which unescorted access to Rockwell facilities might be denied or revoked: Employment with a concern which competes with the Corporation; ownership, partnership or other interest which competes with the Corporation or its suppliers; investment or other beneficial interest by any immediate family member in a competing concern of the Corporation.
